### **Background**

Snohomish County Ordinance 17-003, passed in March of 2017, established the Snohomish County Airport Commission. Per code, the Commission will be composed of 13 members consisting of one person from each Council district, three persons from the airport tenant community, three persons from the business community, and two persons from the county at large.

Pursuant to SCC 2.03.030, the County Executive recommends the re-appointment of Kurtis Lewko for a second term representing airport tenants. The new term is to expire January 31, 2026.
