APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO SIGN THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE PORT OF EVERETT, SNOHOMISH COUNTY, AND THE CITY OF EVERETT REGARDING COST SHARING FOR JETTY LANDING PARK PLAYGROUND

Summary: The Jetty Landing facilities are owned in common by the Port, the County, and the City of Everett for the benefit of the public. The County Executive and the County Council have determined that it is consistent with the Comprehensive Parks and Recreation Plan, and in the public interest of County residents to participate in joint undertakings with local municipalities to increase recreational opportunities and facility capacity. The County, the Port of Everett and the City of Everett have negotiated the terms of an interlocal agreement to share the cost of a playground at Jetty Landing Park. The Port will pay the estimated cost of \$316,566.24 and the County will reimburse the Port \$50,000.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.


