**Subject:** Snohomish Regional Drug Task Force – Interlocal Agreement

**Scope:** Motion 24-529 would approve the annual Interlocal Agreement for the Snohomish County Regional Drug Task Force for 2025, to continue multijurisdictional efforts across Snohomish County to target drug trafficking and money laundering organizations. This contract is substantially similar to prior contracts.

**Authority Granted:** Authorizes the Executive to execute the agreement.

**Background:** Since 1988 the United States Department of Justice has provided funds to the Washington State Department of Commerce under the Anti-Drug Abuse Act to provide grants to local governments for drug law enforcement. Snohomish County, and its cities, have been participating members since the inception of the Act, forming the [Snohomish County Regional Drug & Gang Task Force \(Task Force\)](#).

The Task Force is a multi-jurisdictional group created to coordinate law enforcement activities, resources, and functions with the intent of disrupting illegal drug trafficking systems and removing traffickers. Snohomish County serves as the fiduciary for the Task Force.

The current ILA the Task Force is operating under began in 2021 and has been extended three additional one-year terms as allowed by the ILA. The final extension of the ILA is set to expire on December 31, 2024 and a new ILA is necessary to continue operations.
