<u>Summary:</u> The ordinance amends Title 2 of Snohomish County Code (SCC) to facilitate a variety of innovative funding methods, including, but not limited to, sponsorships, agreements with vendors and public and private partnerships. A brief summary is as follows:

<u>Section 1 and Section 4</u>. New sections 2.16.025 and 2.32.160 are added to allow for sponsorship agreements for contributions for park improvements, maintenance, and park operations, or for entertainment, activities, and events, provided they follow approved conditions. The proposed language outlines conditions, timing, review, and approval processes.

The new sections were further amended at the Public Hearing to establish a monetary amount when Council review of acceptance of sponsorships is required and create an annual reporting of applied sponsorships, to be received by Council from the County Executive, and or designee

<u>Section 2.</u> Amends Section 2.32.140 to include updated language regarding the County's budget cycle and to submit a proposed budget for operations of the fair and fairgrounds to the Director of the Division of Parks and Recreation.

<u>Section 3.</u> Amends Section 2.32.150 to include the Department Director and Risk Manager (or designee) to approve and/or extend licensing agreements for additional terms for up to no more than four years
