Authorizing the County Executive to sign Amendment No. 1 to the Human Services Addendum to the 2023 Master Collective Bargaining Agreement between Snohomish County and the Washington State Council of County and City Employees, AFSCME, AFL-CIO.

Background

This amendment will increase the stipend for qualified employees who volunteer to take and cover an additional 8-hour shift staffing the Involuntary Treatment Unit on the days off from the current \$400 and increase it to \$600. The stipend amount had not been modified on over ten years, and the increase will increase the number of volunteers which will help as these staff members are responsible for staffing an Involuntary Treatment Unit 24 hours per day/7 days per week.
