NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that on August 9, 2023, the Snohomish County Council approved Ordinance No. 23-066. A summary is as follows:


ORDINANCE NO. 23-066

APPROVING FORM AGREEMENT FOR EMERGENCY USE FACILITY LICENSE

Summary: The ordinance approves a form agreement for emergency use facility license between Snohomish County and various public entities within the County for the use of their property during emergency events. Prior to its integration into Snohomish County, the Snohomish Health District partnered with public entities for use of their sites during emergency events. The Snohomish County Health Department would like to continue these partnerships to ensure sites would be available in the event of an emergency. During a disaster or emergency event, Snohomish County may utilize sites to provide emergency shelter and mass clinic services to individuals and families affected by disaster or an emergency event. The agreements shall be approved by motion of the County Council.




