AMENDING THE 2023 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN TO EXPAND THE POPULATION SERVED
FOR AN EXISTING CDBG PROJECT

WHEREAS; Snohomish County is the representative member of the Snohomish County Urban County Consortium (Consortium) for purposes of application, receipt, and administration of federal grant funds under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) Program; and

WHEREAS; pursuant to Council Motion 22-165, the 2023 Annual Action Plan was approved on May 3, 2023; and

WHEREAS; the approved 2023 Annual Action Plan included an award of \$139,576 in CDBG funds for the YWCA of Seattle-King County-Snohomish County – Families in Transition (YWCA-FIT) project; and

WHEREAS; the YWCA proposed a substantial amendment to the 2023 AAP to expand the population served by the YWCA-FIT project; and

WHEREAS; the County has complied with the notification requirements regarding this substantial amendment to the Consortium's Housing and Community Development Policy Advisory Board; and


WHEREAS; the County has complied with the Consortium's citizen participation requirements regarding this substantial amendment; and

WHEREAS; substantial amendments to an Annual Action Plan must be approved by the Snohomish County Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, ON MOTION, the 2023 Annual Action Plan is hereby amended to expand the population served for the YWCA FIT project to include low-income, homeless households with disabilities in permanent supportive housing without children as further described in Attachment A; and
