RESOLUTION NO. 23-046

RECOGNIZING DECEMBER 21, 2023, AS NATIONAL HOMELESS PERSONS' MEMORIAL DAY IN SNOHOMISH COUNTY

WHEREAS, since 2011, Snohomish County has participated in National Homeless Persons' Memorial Day which serves to raise awareness of our neighbors without shelter in our community and to remember and honor those who have died while homeless during the year; and

WHEREAS, the vigil is held on December 21st, the longest night of the year, and is sponsored by the Snohomish County Veterans Homelessness Committee; and

WHEREAS, during Snohomish County's 2023 Annual Point in Time (PIT) Count, 1,285 persons did not have a permanent place to stay; representing an increase of 101 people or 8.5% from 2022; and

WHEREAS, of the individuals who were counted, 51 people were unsheltered veterans, 69 were unaccompanied youth and young adults, 573 were adults with a serious mental illness, and 129 were adult survivors of domestic violence; and

WHEREAS, 52 people in Snohomish County passed away while experiencing homelessness in 2020, rising to 64 people in 2021, and 86 people in 2022; and

WHEREAS, on Thursday, December 21st at 5:15 p.m. at the Snohomish County Outdoor Amphitheater, the Snohomish County Veterans Homelessness Committee is hosting the 13th Annual National Homeless Memorial Day Candlelight Vigil, with a special Veterans' salute; and

WHEREAS, Snohomish County is committed to helping all people meet their basic needs and develop their potential through providing social and human services to those in need;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Snohomish County Council does hereby recognize December 21, 2023, as National Homeless Persons' Memorial Day in Snohomish County. All residents and visitors are welcome to join Snohomish County in honoring our neighbors who have lost their lives while homeless in our community.
