



# FAILING TO ADDRESS THE DRUG EPEDEMIC HOLISITCALLY results in FAILED COMMUNITIES

#### Drug Trends

- Fentanyl continues as the most abused drug in region
  - Prevalent and widely used/mixed with heroin, meth or cocaine
- Methamphetamine is widely used and easily obtained
- Cocaine/Crack use is on the increase
- Rave drugs are still accessible with access to Dark Web (LSD, MDMA, Molly, etc.)
- Pills- Diverted Pharmaceuticals and counterfeit. Xanax (very popular), Suboxone, Adderall (particularly with students.)
- Marijuana and MJ derivatives are widely used in school settings particularly in vape pens
