SIGN AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR OVERLAY IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN
SILVER LAKE WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT

Summary: The ordinance approves an agreement with Silver Lake Water and Sewer District for overlay improvements to 132nd/134th/Cathcart Way from Seattle Hill Road to SR9. Silver Lake Water and Sewer District performed sewer line upgrades prior to the overlay which would have required a full width overlay. The County and Silver Lake Water and Sewer District agree that it is mutually beneficial for the County and District to work together cooperatively to complete a single overlay of the affected area. The County and Silver Lake Water and Sewer District have negotiated an ILA for Overlay services.
