Section 1. The County Council makes the following findings of fact:



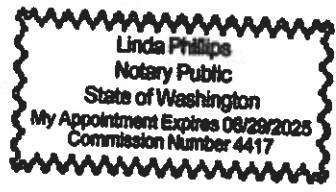


