Re: **Appointment of Alicia Crank to the Public Facilities District Board of Directors**

I am pleased to nominate Alicia Crank for appointment to the Snohomish County Public Facilities District Board (PFD) of Directors. Per SCC 2.19.020, recommendations to the Board shall be made by the Executive and appointed by the Council as required by the County PFD Act.

The Snohomish County Public Facilities District was established in July of 2001. The PFD's purpose is to access state "rebated" sales tax revenues and use these dollars to help construct and operate regional centers throughout the county. Projects that the PFD has formalized funding support for included the Angel of the Winds Casino, Lynnwood Conference Center, Edmonds Center for the Arts, and the Boeing Future of Flight.

Alicia Crank works with both non-profit and for-profit entities, such as the Seattle Sports Commission, the Washington Commercial Aviation Work Group, Washington Business Week, and Chambers of Commerce. Other boards and commissions she has served on include the Edmonds Planning Board, the Snohomish County Airport Commission, and GSBA Policy Council. She is also Women's Pro Hockey Seattle Ambassador Chair. Alicia has proven interests in land use, public spaces, and economic development.

Pursuant to SCC 2.03, I urge the Council's confirmation of Alicia Crank to the PFD Board of Directors to serve an initial term that will expire June 30, 2029.
