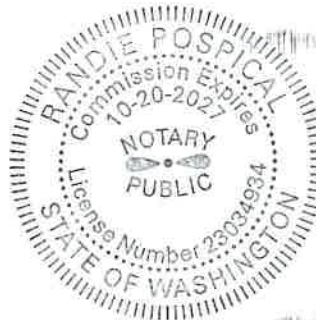

PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 25-027

RELATING TO THE SOLID WASTE SERVICE FEE SCHEDULE
AND CHARGES FOR SECURED LOADS; AMENDING CHAPTER
7.41 SCC

Summary: Tipping fees for municipal solid waste were last adjusted in 2009. Snohomish County Public Works Department's Solid Waste Division (SWD) has recently completed a Cost of Service and Rate Analysis, which created a service and rate model to assist with cost forecasting. After reviewing the results of the analysis, it was determined that the adopted tipping fee schedule was no longer adequate, and a step approach was recommended for increasing the solid waste service fees. The Ordinance would amend the solid waste service fee schedule, update tipping fees and establish a separate fee schedule for waste export specific services starting January 1, 2026. The proposed base rates are recommended to increase annually by 3%, starting on January 1, 2027.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
