ORDINANCE NO. 23-002

RELATING TO THE 2022 BUDGET; MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION IN FUND 124 TO PROVIDE EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY FOR RENTAL ASSISTANCE

Section 1. The County Council makes the following findings of fact: an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$15,000,000 is necessary in Human Services Fund 124, for budget year 2022, to provide expenditure authority for an unanticipated increase in rental assistance needs.
