## Consideration

The proposed motion would approve and authorization of the County Executive to sign an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) between Snohomish County and the Silver Lake Water and Sewer District concerning Utility Construction associated with the 43<sup>rd</sup> Ave SE Road project, under SCC 3.04.140(1) and SCC 3.04.210.

## **Background**

Washington State RCW 39.34 provides for interlocal agreements between local agencies within the state for mutual advantage and thereby to provide services and facilities in a manner beneficial to both agencies. Snohomish County has approved Transportation Improvement Project #E.59, for public road improvements to 43<sup>rd</sup> Ave SE from SR 524 to Sunset Road at 180<sup>th</sup> Street SE, east of the Mill Creek city limits, in unincorporated Snohomish County.

The Silver Lake Water and Sewer District currently has utilities within the County right-ofway and is required by franchise conditions and state law to relocate these facilities to accommodate County initiated public road improvements.

## **Current Proposal**

Scope: An Interlocal Agreement between Snohomish County and the Silver Lake Water and Sewer district is sought for the utility construction and relocation of water lines and associated utility work with the 43<sup>rd</sup> Ave SE Road project.

*Duration:* The duration of this agreement is from execution to completion.

*Fiscal Implications:* The projected reimbursable construction and labor costs associated with the scope of work is \$388,678.04.

<u>Budget Impacts:</u> All costs associated with the utility work will be paid by the Silver Lake Water and Sewer District.
