APPROVE THE AGREEMENT WITH THE EDMONDS SENIOR CENTER (DBA EDMONDS WATERFRONT CENTER) TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR PLINTH FALL HAZARD RAIL AN APPROVED SMALL CAPITAL PROJECTS PARTNERSHIP (SCPP) PROJECT

WHEREAS, RCW 82.46.035 authorized counties planning under the Growth Management Act the authority to levy an additional guarter percent tax on all sales of real estate; and

WHEREAS, by that legislation, this additional guarter percent tax on sales of real estate must be used solely on capital projects that are listed in a capital facilities plan; and

WHEREAS, capital projects are defined as public works projects of a local government for planning, acquisition, construction, reconstruction, repair, replacement, rehabilitation or improvement of streets, roads, highways, sidewalks, street and road lighting systems, traffic signals, bridges, domestic water systems, storm and sanitary sewer systems; and planning, construction, reconstruction, repair, rehabilitation, or improvement of parks; and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 22-059, adopted November 9, 2022, the Snohomish County Council provided funding within the Real Estate Excise Tax Fund for an application process for a Small Capital Projects Partnership (SCPP) grant program; and

WHEREAS, the County received an application for funding assistance from the Edmonds Senior Center; and

WHEREAS, the project requested is located on land owned by the City of Edmonds, and

WHEREAS, the project was evaluated for eligibility and recommended funding for the Plinth Fall Hazard Rail in the amount of \$5,000 consistent with provisions of RCW 82.46.035; and

WHEREAS, by Motion 23-302, approved by County Council on July 11, 2023, Council approved the funding recommendations;

NOW, THEREFORE, ON MOTION, the Council approves the agreement with the Edmonds Senior Center (DBA Edmonds Waterfront Center) in the amount of \$5,000 for Plinth Fall Hazard Rail.
