### **Consideration:**

Authorizing the 2022 Historic Preservation Program Grant Awards.

### **Background**

Ordinance 08-119 establishes funds to authorize the County to administer a Heritage Preservation program to allocate revenues accruing under provision of RCW 36.22.170, which establishes that one dollar of every document recorded by the County Auditor will be designated to the promotion of historic preservation.

The Snohomish County Historic Preservation Commission established grant criteria and an application process to distribute the funds throughout the heritage community and received applications for program assistance from various heritage preservation organizations in response to a public solicitation. The Historic Preservation Commission reviewed 12 applications for the available \$100,000 of funding, with requests totaling \$128,940. The Commission recommends full or partial funding for 11 of those applicants, for a total funding of \$100,000.

### **Current Proposal**

Council approval of the recommended levels as set forth herein authorizes the Director of the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources signature authority to sign the grant agreements and any other documents necessary to effectuate all the terms and conditions of said grant agreements.
