#### Background:

The County's prior agreement with the City of Edmonds was approved on January 23, 2019 via Motion 19-017. The agreement allowed for a two-year term with one three-year extension through 12/31/2024. There is not currently an agreement with the City.

On June 12, 2024, the Council adopted Ordinance 24-041, authorizing a form interlocal agreement for emergency management services with cities, towns, tribes and special purpose districts.
