2022 Operating Budget Decision Points

- ► Maintain flexibility during the pandemic
- Transition to a new property tax software system "Aumentum"
- Address increased volume of real estate excise tax processing
- Provide a new public service for issuance of passports
- ► Increasing billing services to special purpose districts

FTE Requests

- No new employees requested
- ► Request to reclassify Office Assistant II (305) to an Excise Specialist (309)
- ► Fund the position of Tax Collection Specialist (312) that was unfunded in 2021

FTE Positions

- ▶ 29 Positions currently filled
- ▶ 2 vacant positions will be filled with the approved budget
- We will start the recruitment process January 2022

Washington ESHB 1410

- ► Starting in 2022 no penalties for delinquent residential real property (normally 3% on June 1st then 8% on December 1st)
- Starting in 2023 interest reduction for residential real property from 12% to 9%
