ADOPTING CHANGES IN VOTING PRECINCTS PURSUANT TO RCW 29A.16.040, RCW 29A.16.050 AND CHAPTER 2.47 SCC; AMENDING CHAPTER 2.47 SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE

Snohomish County Elections is required to examine and adjust precinct boundaries to account for boundary changes following the federal decennial census, annexations to cities/districts and population shifts on an annual basis.

Pursuant to the authority of Snohomish County Code (SCC) 2.47.040(2), the Snohomish County Auditor proposes adjustments to voting precinct boundaries due to district boundary changes, annexations and population shifts as required by state and local statute and in a manner that supports efficient election administration. The total number of precincts resulting from these adjustments is 852.

SCC 2.47.030 Precincts Adopted, last amended by Ordinance 22-013 on April 13, 2022, is amended to adopt Exhibit A attached to the proposed Ordinance.

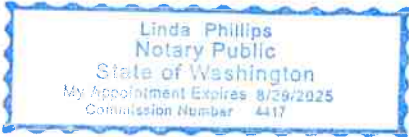
