

APPROVING DATA SHARINS AGREEMENT WITH STATE OF WASHINGTON DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR THE REFUGEE HEALTH PROMOTION PROGRAM

Background: The ordinance approves a data sharing agreement with Washington Department of Health (DOH) to cultine the conditions that require the Health Department to submit required Refugee Health Promotion (RHP) program data to DOH. The goal of Ri-P, funded by the Office of Refugee Resettlement (ORR), is to promote the health and well-being of refugees and other ORR eligible communities. RHP focuses on three key service types: 1) provide apportunities to increase health literacy, 2) coordinate health care, and 3) organize wellness groups. Through an intragency agreement, Department of Social and Health Sarvices (OSHS) is partnering with DOH to provide RHP services to ORR-eligible communities. DOH will subcontract with Local Health Jurisdictions (LHJs) to provide services focused on health iteracy and health navigation through community health workers.

At the Public Heating, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.


