GRANTING A NONEXCLUSIVE CABLE FRANCHISE AUTHORIZING
LIMITED USE OF THE PUBLIC ROAD RIGHTS-OF-WAY IN
SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON TO COMCAST CABLE
COMMUNICATIONS, LLC AND COMCAST CABLE COMMUNICATIONS
MANAGEMENT, LLC, JOINTLY AND SEVERALLY

Comcast Cable Communications, LLC and Comcast Cable Communications Management, LLC, both Washington corporations, have applied to Snohomish County, Washington, for a non-exclusive franchise to construct, maintain, operate, replace and repair a cable system in, on, across, over, along, under, and/or through public rights-of-way within unincorporated Snohomish County:

If approved, proposed Ordinance No. 22-026 would grant said franchise to Comcast Cable Communications, LLC and Comcast Cable Communications Management, LLC, subject to all of the terms and conditions contained in the ordinance.
