



I am writing regarding an application that I believe you folks have received. I have contacted Snohomish County Planning and Development but they do not have a record of this request at this time. The application indicates it should be filed with the County Legislative Authority. I am unsure where this application is currently located. It is stamped OPEN SPACE Assessor's Application No. 3319

I believe there is inaccurate information in this request. It is a regarding Parcel number 31050400300500 which borders along the Stillaguamish River just north of Arlington in Snohomish County WA.

This parcel currently does not have easement access and the county has no record that an easement was ever granted for the parcel. The folks who submitted this request also own parcel number 31050900200300.

These parcels both have stream protection designation as fish habitat including wetlands. There is no agricultural activity north of the Stillaguamish at this location. The area is zoned R-5.

I am unsure what the folks hope to accomplish by changing this designation but equestrian activities would not be a good fit for a parcel in the wetlands habitat of the Stillaguamish River.
