<u>Authority Granted:</u> Snohomish County Council finds that it is in the public interest to allow Surface Water Management to acquire the property known as 14332 164th Street NE, Arlington, WA 98223 and allow the Property Officer of the Department of Facilities and Fleet to sign all necessary documentation to complete the acquisition of the property on behalf of Snohomish County, under SCC 4.46.115(14).

<u>Background:</u> In 2018 Mr. Lundy was given notice from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) that his property was designated for Pre-Disaster Flood Mitigation Assistance and /or Hazard Mitigation Grant Funds to relocate or purchase the property. Legal description is Lot 7, JORDAN RIVER TRAILS DIVISION NO.2, according to the plat thereof, recorded in Volume 25 of Plats, pages 64 and 65, in Snohomish County, Washington.

SWM of Snohomish County has received a grant from FEMA to acquire the property and to demolish structures, with the intent of preventing negative impacts and contamination of the South Fork of the Stillaguamish River. All parties and departments involved in the transaction have been conferred with and agree with the transaction as described therein.
