reflect current park improvement project costs and anticipated
population growth in accordance with the adopted level-of-service
standards set forth in the proposed 2025-2030 Parks Capital
Improvement Program (CIP). The Washington State Legislature
amended RCW 82.02.660 requiring proportionally lower impact fee
for smaller housing units and requires jurisdictions to adopt the
revised fee schedule within sk months after the comprehensive
plan update The 2024 Snohomish County Comprehensive Plan
was adopted December 4, 2025, and effective December 22, 2024.
Parks has conducted public outreach in developing the proposed
amendments to Chapter 30.66A SCC, which are proposed by this
ordinance, including webpage postings and newsletter updates, a
scpPA checklist processes, and Planning Commission or
January 28, 2025, to amend SCC 30.66A to update the fee
schedule pursuant to RC

At the Public Hearing, the Council will consider a Proposed Substitute Ordinance making technical corrections to the proposed ordinance. The Council may also consider additional amendments.

Range of Possible Actions the County Council May Take on This Proposal: At the conclusion of the public hearing, the County Council may make one of the following decisions: (1) adopt the Planning Commission recommendations; (2) adopt an amended version of the Planning Commission recommendations; (3) decline to adopt the Planning Commission recommendations; (4) remand in whole or in part to the Planning Commission for further consideration; (6) adopt such other proposals or modification of such proposals as were considered by the Council at its own hearing; or (6) take any other action permitted by law.
