Consideration

Authorizing the Snohomish County Executive to sign on behalf of Snohomish County an agreement between Snohomish County and the Lake Stevens Food Bank.

Background

Snohomish County Council appropriated funding for Council projects as part of the 2022 Adopted Budget, further amended by Ordinance 22-001.

The Lake Stevens Food Bank provides food to approximately 41,000 low-income and disabled people on an annual basis and with the new building site, the Food Bank will be able to increase their capacity to provide food by 50%.

Current Proposal

Scope: Motion 22-340 approves the agreement between Snohomish County and the Lake Stevens Food Bank for a reimbursement-based grant.

Duration: Effective upon full execution to the date the building is usable by the public as a food bank.
