### **Consideration:**

The Executive requests Council approve a five-year license agreement with Butler Amusements, Inc. for carnival operations at the Evergreen State Fair.

### **Background:**

Snohomish County owns the Evergreen State Fairgrounds and holds an annual Fair from the end of August through Labor Day. Carnival services for the Fair are contracted out, with a portion of the revenue from the rides and concessions going to the County/Fair. For over 20 years Butler Amusements, Inc. has provided carnival services at the Evergreen State Fair (selected through an RFP process).

The most recent contract was entered into in 2011<sup>1</sup> (2011-2015), extended through Amendment #1<sup>2</sup> (2016-2020), and Amendment #2<sup>3</sup> approved changes to the financials of the contract. Due to Covid-19, the 2020 Fair was canceled which was the last year of the contract with Butler Amusements. Because of this, under Executive Authority Amendment #3 was executed to essentially carry forward the services that would have been provided in 2020, to 2021 (see attachment #1).

### **Current Proposal:**

**Scope:** Provide amusement rides, shows, novelty concessions, game concessions, and food concessions at the Evergreen State Fair. For the rides there must be at least two super spectacular rides; four spectacular rides, 14 major adult rides, 14 family/kiddie rides, and two walk-through funhouse shows. For concessions the contractor will provide between three to five miscellaneous novelty concessions, between 20 to 35 game concessions, and no more than seven food concessions.

**Duration:** 2022 – 2026

**Budget:** Under the contract, Butler Amusement, Inc. agrees to pay the County a minimum of \$900k/year 2022-2025 and \$950k in 2026 based on the below formula.

There are a couple notable financial changes from 2019.<sup>4</sup> The percent the County is receiving from Advance Sale Ride Gross dropped 10% from 2019; there is a 2% increase on what the county will receive from Super Spectacular Ride's; revenue from novelty sales is a flat \$2k on gross sales vs. \$1.5k per concession; food concession revenue

increases by \$700 per concession; and the minimum guaranteed amount is almost \$300k higher than in 2019.
