APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO SIGN THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN SNOHOMISH COUNTY AND THE SNOHOMISH CONSERVATION DISTRICT TO IMPLEMENT PORTIONS OF THE SHORELANDS FLOODPLAINS BY DESIGN PHASE II AGREEMENT.

Summary: The ordinance approves an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) with the Snohomish Conservation District for \$2,338,730 to implement portions of the Shorelands Floodplain by Design Phase II Agreement. Snohomish County was awarded \$8,564,176 in grant funds from the Washington State Department of Ecology for the Community Floodplain Solutions project that advances execution of integrated floodplain management in the Snohomish Watershed, with focus on the Lower Skykomish River. The Snohomish Conservation District's tasks include Integrated Team Support, Riparian Forest Health Implementation, Riley and Haskel Sough Water Conveyance and Connectivity Improvements and Agricultural Resilience Programmatic and Cost-Share Support. The term of the ILA is through June 30, 2025.
