Archdiocesan Housing Authority (AHA) collaborates with Catholic Community Services of Western Washington (CCS); AHA provides operating support through a property manager and CCS provides case management and other supportive services to assist participants in achieving housing stability.
Catholic Community Services: Clare's Place (Everett Safe Streets Supportive Housing)	\$439,072	Supportive services for sixty-five (65) units of PSH in Everett for CH individuals, young adults aged 18 to 24, and veterans. CCS provides case management and other supportive services to assist participants in achieving housing stability.
Catholic Community Services: Home Connection	\$575,132	Thirty-eight (38) scattered-site units of PSH throughout Snohomish County for CH individuals. CCS provides tenant-based rental assistance, case management, and other supportive services to assist participants in achieving housing stability.
Catholic Community Services: Homeless Families, Home at Last	\$267,799	Ten (10) scattered-site units of PSH throughout Snohomish County for CH families. CCS provides tenant-based rental assistance, case management, and other supportive services to assist participants in achieving housing stability.
Catholic Community Services: Journey Home	\$424,181	Twenty (20) scattered-site units of PSH throughout Snohomish County for CH individuals, with a priority for CH veterans. CCS provides tenant-based rental assistance, case management, and other supportive services to assist participants in achieving housing stability.
Catholic Community Services: Meadowdale	\$243,789	Fourteen (14) scattered-site units of PSH throughout Snohomish County for CH individuals. CCS provides tenant-based rental assistance, case management and other supportive services to assist participants in achieving housing stability.
Catholic Community Services: The Road Home	\$381,984	Seventeen (17) scattered-site units of PSH throughout Snohomish County for CH individuals. CCS provides tenant-based rental assistance, case management, and other supportive services to assist participants in achieving housing stability.
Catholic Community Services: Veteran's Permanent Housing	\$130,248	Eight (8) scattered-site units of PSH throughout Snohomish County for CH veterans. CCS provides tenant-based rental assistance, case management, and other supportive services to assist participants in achieving housing stability.
Domestic Violence Services: DV Rapid Rehousing	\$177,847	Six (6) scattered-site units of RRH at confidential locations for survivors of domestic violence and their families. Domestic Violence Services of Snohomish County (DVSSC) provides tenant-based rental assistance, case management, and other supportive services to assist participants in achieving housing stability.
Domestic Violence Services: DV Rapid Rehousing Non-CoC Expansion	\$309,105	Ten (10) scattered-site units of RRH at confidential locations for survivors of domestic violence and their families. DVSSC provides tenant-based rental assistance, case management, and other supportive services to assist participants in achieving housing stability.
Domestic Violence Services: DV Joint TH-RRH	\$541,814	Four (4) leased units of transitional housing (TH) and twelve (12) scattered-site units of RRH at confidential locations for survivors of domestic violence and their families. DVSSC provides transitional housing, tenant-based rental assistance, case management, and other supportive services to assist participants in achieving housing stability.

Housing Hope: Beachwood North	\$40,082	Seven (7) units of PSH for CH families in Marysville and Everett. Housing Hope provides housing, case management, and other supportive services to assist participants in achieving housing stability.
Housing Hope: Housing Hope Village	\$153,774	Thirteen (13) units of PSH for CH families in Everett. Housing Hope provides housing, case management, and other supportive services to assist participants in achieving housing stability.
Interfaith: Rapid Rehousing	\$305,111	Ten (10) scattered-site units of RRH through Snohomish County for homeless families with children. The Interfaith Association of Northwest Washington provides tenant-based rental assistance, case management, and other supportive services to assist participants in achieving housing stability.
Snohomish County: CoC Planning	\$354,766	Design and carry out a collaborative planning process for the development of an application to HUD; evaluate outcomes for projects funded under CoC and Emergency Solutions Grant programs; participate in consolidated plans for the local geographic areas.
Snohomish County: Coordinated Entry	\$136,855	Operation of the Snohomish County Coordinated Entry system. The project provides initial, comprehensive assessments of the needs of homeless individuals and families for housing and services and prioritizes homeless individuals and families for assistance.
Snohomish County: HMIS Lead	\$212,216	Operation of the Snohomish County Homeless Management Information System (HMIS); review and revise HIMS policies and procedures which include a privacy plan, a security plan, and a data quality plan; ensure consistent participation of recipients and subrecipients in the HMIS; ensure the HMIS is administered in compliance with HUD requirements.
Snohomish County: UFA Costs	\$354,766	Ensure that financial transactions for all CoC-projects are conducted in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles; monitor all CoC subrecipients and enforce compliance.
YWCA: Community Rapid Rehousing	\$245,782	Seven (7) scattered-site units of RRH through Snohomish County for homeless individuals and families. The YWCA provides tenant-based rental assistance, case management, and other supportive services to assist participants in achieving housing stability.
YWCA: Long Term Leasing for the Chronically Homeless Disabled	\$401,160	Eighteen (18) scattered-site units of PSH throughout Snohomish County for CH individuals. The YWCA of Seattle, King County, Snohomish County (YWCA) provides tenant-based rental assistance and partners with other agencies to provide case management and other supportive services to assist participants in achieving housing stability.
YWCA: Long Term Leasing for the Disabled	\$361,499	Seventeen (17) scattered-site units of PSH throughout Snohomish County for CH individuals. The YWCA provides tenant-based rental assistance and partners with other agencies to provide case management and other supportive services to assist participants in achieving housing stability.
YWCA: Pathways Home Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH)	\$278,318	Ten (10) scattered-site units of PSH throughout Snohomish County for CH individuals and families. YWCA: Shelter Plus Care	\$5,415,398	Two hundred twenty-eight (228) units of PSH, including forty (40) site-based units in Everett and one hundred eighty-eight (188) scattered units throughout Snohomish County, for CH individuals and families.
