Subject: Pharmaceutical Services – Snohomish County Jail

Scope: Diamond Drug, Inc. shall provide pharmaceutical services within the

Snohomish County Jail. Under the contract, they will be responsible for providing prescription and non-prescription drugs, IV's, consultations, emergency pharmacy services, medication carts and cabinets, and all hardware/technology necessary for receiving, distributing, and billing pharmaceuticals within the Snohomish County Jail. A detailed scope of services can be found in Schedule A of the contract. Schedule B outlines

the compensation plan.

Duration: 5-year contract June 1, 2024 – May 31, 2029

Annual expenses are estimated to be \$650k/12 months. Prescription drugs dispensed to inmates will be billed to the county at the direct wholesale cost, plus \$3.15/per prescription.

<u>Background:</u> In 1998 the Snohomish County Jail brought pharmaceutical services inhouse for inmates in the County Jail. The first contract for this services was approved in December 1998, through Motion 98-424, with David Rose (also referred to as Summit Consulting). Since then, the provider for this service has changed twice (see below). The most recent contract, approved through Motion 13-447, is with Diamond Drugs, Inc.

The contract before you is a result of RFP 24-001BC and would approve a new contract with Diamond Drugs, Inc.

1998 through January 2006 Summit Consulting

March 2006 through March 2013 Bridgeport Pharmacy Services

June 2013 through Present Dimond Drug, Inc.
