Consideration:

Approve a form agreement for Mobile Vaccination Site License's.

Background:

Prior to its integration into the County, the Snohomish Health District held agreements with various entities to allow for them to use space at each entities property for the District to operate Mobile Vaccination Sites for the purpose of serving underserved communities. With the integration into the County, new agreements must be executed.

Current Proposal:

Scope: Approve a form agreement for Mobile Vaccination Sites and authorize final motions to be approved by Council by motion.

Under the agreement, an entity will grant the County a 50 square foot location at each of their properties for Mobile Vaccination Sites. The sites are authorized to provide childhood, flu, and COVID vaccinations and events, dates, times, and other details shall be agreed to by both the County and entity.

Duration: TBD, each agreement can have a different termination date. Either party can terminate the agreement with 72 hours written or telephonic notice.

Fiscal Impact: None, because the services provided are considered a public purpose, use of the sites will be free to the County.
