Section 2. Assessment Zones. The District has two assessment zones: a full benefit zone and a non-benefit zone. Section 6. This ordinance shall have a prospective effect and shall supersede the District's system of assessment last finalized by Snohomish County Ordinance 17-052 adopted on August 9, 2017.
