PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 24-105

APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO SIGN AN
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN SNOHOMISH COUNTY
AND THE CITY OF MONROE, FOR THE MONROE 30 ANNEXATION

Background: This ordinance proposes to authorize the County Executive to enter into an interlocal agreement (ILA) with the City of Monroe to facilitate the transfer of jurisdiction and orderly development regarding the Monroe 30 Annexation.

A summary of the proposed ordinance is as follows:

Section 1. Adopts recitals, findings of fact, and conclusions.

Section 2. Authorizes the County Executive to enter into the ILA with the City of Monroe.
