RELATING TO THE 2024 BUDGET; MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN PARKS CONSTRUCTION FUND 309 TO PROVIDE EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY FOR IMPROVEMENTS AT KAYAK POINT PARK

**Summary:** The ordinance approves a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$450,000 in Parks Construction Fund 309 to establish expenditure authority to complete the pier replacement project at Kayak Point Park. Snohomish County Parks obtained funding from the Port of Everett as a result of their Consent Decree to settle a dispute regarding National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit requirements. As part of the settlement, the parties identified Snohomish County's Kayak Point Park pier piling replacement project for receiving supplemental environmental project (SEP) funds. The funds can only be used for the water quality project planned at Kayak Point Park in Snohomish County.


