<u>Authority Granted:</u> Authorizes the Executive Directors' signature authority to sign the agreements on behalf of Snohomish County and any other documents to effectuate all the terms and conditions of said agreements; and authorizes the Executive to execute the necessary contracts.

Background: Ordinance 87-062 authorizes the County to administer a program to allocate revenues accruing to it under provisions of RCW 67.28.1801. These funds are reserved for support of tourism development and promotion projects.

Snohomish County Code 4.40.050 establishes that funds collected under the section may be used to assist in defraying costs associated with projects designed to attract visitors to the County or encourage expansion of tourism.

Requested Action: Move to GLS on December 13th for consideration.
