APPROVING ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS PRESENTED AT
GENERAL LEGISLATIVE SESSION ON JUNE 10, 2026

WHEREAS, the Snohomish County Charter requires the Snohomish County Council to consider and approve certain proposed actions that are of a routine, recurring and non-controversial nature; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that review and approval of such routine, recurring and non-controversial matters together in a single written motion is an efficient way to process such items and maintains effective oversight of administrative operations; and

WHEREAS, the following action items were presented at a General Legislative Session where such matters are routinely considered;

NOW, THEREFORE, ON MOTION, the Snohomish County Council hereby approves the following action items:

- a. Approving the following Purchasing Award Recommendations:
 - 1) Piggyback Award Recommendation for Purchasing/County-wide use of a “piggyback” approved and awarded by King County for Temporary Personnel Services, in accordance with the Council approved Intergovernmental Cooperative Purchasing agreement with King County, as authorized under Motion 13-319, on an “as-needed” basis for a proposed term of three (3) years for an estimated spend of \$350,000 ([ECAF 2026-1406](#))
 - 2) Bid Award Recommendation for Ash Way Overlay 164th ST SW to Park and Ride to JB Asphalt for award amount of \$806,126.50 plus applicable Washington State Sales Tax ([ECAF 2026-1439](#))
 - 3) Bid Award Recommendation for Beverly Park Road ADA Upgrades & 18th Ave West Sidewalk Improvements to RRJ Company LLC for award amount of \$561,860.61 plus applicable Washington State Sales Tax ([ECAF 2026-1440](#))
