<u>Background:</u> The Washington Department of Commerce has implemented a Low-Income Energy Efficiency (LIEE) Program using funds provided by Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) to provide weatherization service to electrically heated low-income homes within the BPA Service Territory. The Department of Commerce has authorized the Snohomish County Weatherization Program to administer the BPA LIEE Program in accordance with county, state, federal laws, and regulations.
