Subject: Interlocal Agreement with the City of Seattle by and through its City Light Department for Technology Services

Scope: This is an agreement between Snohomish County and City of Seattle to provide orthoimagery and GIS support services upon request by City Light. The County will also provide up to ten (10) EagleView CONNECTExplorer accounts. Services are detailed in Exhibit A – Work Order. The agreement allows the city to request services from the mutual agreed upon County Work Order (WO).

Authority Granted: Approves and authorizes the County Executive to execute the Interlocal Agreement as well as any associated amendments and work orders between Snohomish County and the City of Seattle by and through its City Light Department.

Background: The County has agreed to share imagery with City Light, and City Light has agreed to share the associated cost. The cost for services for the full term of the ILA through December 31, 2027, and all work orders under this ILA shall not exceed \$26,250. Revenues are subject to increase based on the purchase of additional services by City Light and the approved rate model during the year the work is effective.

The County will provide City Light with orthoimagery for City Light’s identified area of interest, which includes aerial imagery within County limits, through the County’s agreement with EagleView (Pictometry International Corp.). The County will also provide up to ten (10) EagleView CONNECTExplorer accounts (Appendix A to Exhibit A). To receive these services, City Light shall execute an Authorized Subdivision Agreement with EagleView (Appendix B to Exhibit A) and will submit the Subdivision Agreement to the County for processing.

Requested Action: For Council to move to GLS on April 29, 2026 for consideration.
