**Subject:** Approving the City of Marysville Interlocal Agreement for flood mitigation CLFR-119b.

**Background:** Snohomish County secured Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery (CLFR) grant funds under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). Guidelines for these funds allow the County to transfer funds to a special purpose district of state or local government as a subrecipient. City of Marysville is a public agency under RCW 39.34 and is important to public safety.
