## Consideration

The Executive's Office requests Council consider approving proposed Motion 21-302, which would approve and authorize Amendment No. 1 to the agreement between Snohomish County and Ideal Option relating to Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) Services.

## **Background**

On August 19, 2021, the County entered into an agreement with Ideal Options for a period of six years approved by Motion 20-303.<sup>1</sup> This agreement authorized Ideal Option to establish a MAT clinic and provide MAT services five (5) days a week for three (3) hours a day in the Snohomish County Jail.

Due to the reduced jail population which is impacting the types of services needed, both parties wish to amend the agreement's hours of service and fee structure.

## **Current Proposal**

Scope: Motion 21-302 approves Amendment No. 1 and authorizes the Executive to sign the necessary agreements. Although the type and length of minimum services required is amended, the hourly rate stays the same. Also added to Amendment No. 1 is an exclusion for seven (7) federal holidays.

MAT Services (\$170/hour)	3 hours per day, M-F	Onsite: 2-hour minimum, M-F. Additional time billed in 15 min. increments.  Telehealth: \$250/hour billed in 15 min increments
Onsite Care Coordination (\$40/hour)	3 hours per day, M-F	8 hours per day, M-F

All other terms and conditions remain the same.

*Duration:* January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2025. Extensions allowed for three (3) additional one (1) year terms.
