## **Consideration:**

The proposed motion would authorize the Snohomish County Executive to execute Amendment No. 8 to the professional services agreement for Master Plan Update and Day-Use improvements at Kayak Point Park, under SCC 3.04.190.

## **Background:**

In 2016 Snohomish County selected J.A. Brennan Associates, PLLC, through RFQ-04-16SB, following established Federal, State and County policies. An Agreement was negotiated for consultant services to provide park design, engineering, and permit support, including construction administration services with a conceptual plan developed for the day-use portion of the park and to also develop a Preferred Plan for the undeveloped portion of the park. The original agreement for \$554,999 was approved by Motion 16-425 on October 11, 2016. To date a total of seven (7) Amendments to the original contract have been approved by either the Executive or Council:
