Subject: Emergency messaging to County employees.

Scope: The proposed contract Amendment 3 would allow emergency messaging out to County employees via Recurring Desktop Alert and Optional Soft Panic Button License with Rave Wireless, for a total amount of \$6,684.93.

Duration: The current contract agreement term ends February 11, 2025, no change is proposed at this time.

Authority Granted: Authorize the County Executive to execute Amendment 3.

Background: In February of 2020 Snohomish County entered into a Software as a Service Agreement ("Agreement") with Rave Wireless for the agreed to new integrated notification system. Snohomish County selected Rave Wireless, through RFP-11-19SB, following established Federal, State and County policies to provide an "out of the box" 24 hour a day, 7 days a week support that would integrate with existing County public safety systems Sno911 and Smart911 with minimal configuration.

Snohomish County and Rave Wireless amended the Agreement in October 2021 to include one additional SMS to Opt-in a keyword to support Airport operations and public safety. The Agreement was amended in January 2023 to add 10DLC numbers and an additional 150,000 SMS messages annually.

The County's Campus Security Team has assessed options to get emergency messaging out to County employees. Rave has offered fixed pricing for the Recurring Desktop Alert and Optional Soft Panic Button License through the current term of the contract for an additional amount.

Action Requested: Move to GLS on September 13, 2023, for consideration.
