This letter confirms Snohomish County's desire to enter a broadband technical partnership with Broadlinc, a public development authority that acts on behalf of Spokane County for all things broadband-related. We believe by working together we can maximize the benefits of the broadband technical assistance funds appropriated by the State Legislature to the Department of Commerce, which are being managed by the Washington State Association of Counties.
