**Summary:** The ordinance approves an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$150,000 in the Employee Benefit Fund 508. The County is required by RCW to pay for necessary medical costs for LEOFF 1 retirees. The LEOFF 1 Disability Board reviews and approves medical claims reimbursement. The year-to-date claims are higher than anticipated in the 2023 Budget requiring an appropriation of fund balance to increase expenditure authority




