**Background:** On May 28, 2024 the Executive executed an initial contract with Shannon Ragonesi at Keating, Bucklin and McCormack for legal services in the amount of \$50,000, in accordance with <u>SCC 3.04.140(2)</u>, for defense of two deputies in the Whybark matter. All parties are currently working through discovery, and it is anticipated that work will continue for the unforeseeable future, necessitating an amendment to the original contract to increase the do not exceed amount by an additional \$100,000. Council approval is necessary as the original contract amount was for the maximum amount allowed under code to be approved by the Executive for this type of contract.
