**Subject:** Amendment 19 to Siemens Industry Inc. Agreement is to include Notice

of ARPA CLFR Funding Provisions Letter.

**Scope:** The Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (CLFR) pursuant to the

American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) language is required to be added to Technical Services Agreements when the vendor is providing or performs services on projects related to and involving ARPA CLFR funding. Council appropriated \$6,850,000.00 to upgrade the Auditor's Election Space, as a county facility in the 2023 budget. This includes upgrades and

standardization of the County's card access systems.

**<u>Duration:</u>** The proposed Amendment 19 amends the existing agreement to include

required language to comply with additional terms and conditions due to federal requirements. It does not alter the original term of the

agreement.

**Background:** The County and Siemens Industry, Inc. entered into a Technical Services Agreement to upgrade and standardize the County's card access systems in various County facilities in 2018. Since then, additional facilities and security expansions have been added, including contract extensions via amendments.
