**RECOGNIZING JUNE 5, 2026, AS “SPRING INTO RECOVERY DAY”
IN SNOHOMISH COUNTY**

WHEREAS, Snohomish County Recovery Coalition started in 2023 to advocate and support meaningful actions that promote connection, equity, and recovery; and

WHEREAS, we envision a community that supports recovery in all its forms, while recognizing that not all paths to recovery are the same, and recovery requires racial equity and social justice to ensure that resources are inclusive and accessible to all; and

WHEREAS, recovery is a process, and people in Snohomish County can and do recover with support, we should recognize all paths to recovery and the four dimensions of recovery from mental health and substance use disorder: health, home, purpose, and community; and

WHEREAS, we all must work to de-stigmatize, listen to, help, and better understand those with mental health and substance use disorders by speaking out and centering lived experiences, building community, understanding and promoting recovery; and

WHEREAS, we all must work collaboratively and creatively to remove barriers and close gaps to sustained, meaningful recovery; and

WHEREAS, we must encourage every community member to implement preventive measures, recognize problematic signs, and guide people in need of help to the appropriate recovery support services and resources;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Snohomish County Council does hereby recognize June 5, 2026, as “Spring into Recovery Day” in Snohomish County and encourages all residents, businesses, and visitors to support recovery support services and resources, together we can build community and support each other to thrive.
