Consideration

The Executive's Office requests Council consider approving proposed Motion 21-292, which would approve the nomination of Michele Meaker to the North Sound Behavioral Health Administrative Services Organization Advisory Board.

Background

The NSBHO Advisory Board provides independent advice to the North Sound Behavioral Health – Administrative Services Organization Board of Directors, local jurisdictions, and service providers.

The board is comprised of twenty-six (26) members from the five (5) counties represented in the region. Of that, Snohomish County has nine (9) members on the board. Members serve three (3) year terms and cannot serve more than three (3) consecutive terms.¹

Current Proposal

Scope: Motion 21-292 would confirm the appointment of Michele Meaker to the North Sound Behavioral Health Administrative Services Organization Advisory Board. Michele resides in District 2 and would be one (1) of seven (7) Snohomish County representatives.

Michele is the former Executive Director of the National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) Eastside and provides a vital link between public mental health providers and the community at large.

Duration: If confirmed, Michele's first term would expire on August 31, 2024.
