Based on the Agreement of the parties to the above-referenced Contract between the North Sound Behavioral Health Administrative Services Organization, LLC (North Sound BH-ASO) and Snohomish County (Provider) dated December 26, 2019, (as amended by North Sound BH-ASO and Provider dated July 27, 2020, collectively the "Contract") is hereby amended as follows:

The purpose of this amendment is to add funding for the period of January-December 2021.

By mutual agreement of the parties, the following language is added to the agreement:

1. Replace NS BH-ASO-Snohomish County Budget 2020-A with NS BH-ASO-Snohomish County Budget 2020-21B
2. Replace Exhibit A-i with Exhibit A-ii
