Subject: Amendment No.1 to the Agreement for Substance Use Peer Navigation

Program with Ideal Option PLLC

Scope: Amendment No. 1 to the contract with Ideal Option PLLC for peer navigation services increases the contract total by \$79,510, bringing the

not-to-exceed amount to \$213,500. The grant amount is increasing due to a notice of a grant award from Health and Human Services through the Centers for for Disease Control and Prevention for overdose

prevention.

Additionally, Amendment No. 1 revises the contract duration and attachments. The duration is extended until May 31, 2025. Attachment A is revised to clarify that 1 FTE Peer Navigator will serve at the Snohomish County Jail and 1 FTE Peer Navigator will operate out of the Emergency Department at Providence Regional Medical Center in Everett. Attachment B is updated to show billing amounts during the

extended contract period.

Duration: April 1, 2024, through May 31, 2025 and may be renewed for up to 4

additional 1-year terms.

<u>Authority Granted:</u> Motion 24-365 authorizes the County Executive to sign Amendment No. 1 to the contract with Ideal Option PLLC for a substance use peer navigation program.

Background: On July 17, 2024, Council passed Motion 24-264¹, approving the agreement with Ideal Option PLLC for peer navigation services in the amount of \$133,990. This project provides support to individuals in Snohomish County using substances who might be incarcerated, homeless, or have recently experienced an

overdose. Peer navigators build relationships with clients, identify readiness to access treatment for substance use disorder, and works with them to achieve their personal goals.

On May 22, 2024, Council passed Motion 24-187² approving execution of an agreement with Ideal Option PLLC for transportation and peer navigation services in the Sky Valley Corridor.
